## What Projects Include



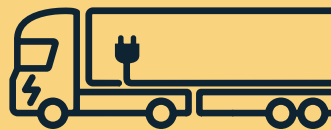
### Community Outreach

Strategies that use zero-emission equipment, reduce truck idling, support clean energy, include charging stations if feasible, and include air quality monitoring.

Support local economies and access to workforce training, apprenticeships and regular reporting on community benefits.
