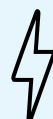
Rebate to offset the cost of DC fast chargers for Class 4-8 vehicles only.



Each charger must have a minimum output of 250 kW.



Installation costs of equipment is also eligible for funding.



Rebate is up to \$700 per kW based on rated charging output.



Project area includes San Pedro Bay Ports through Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino and Riverside Counties.
